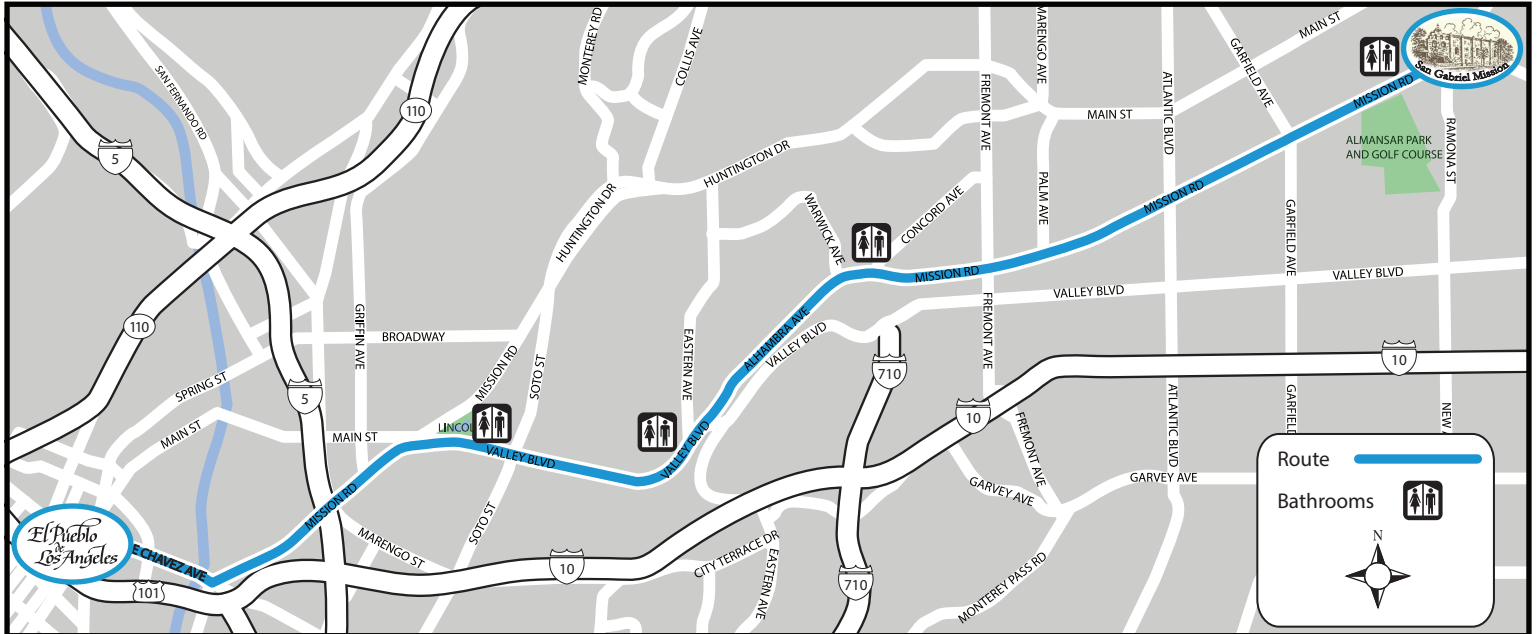

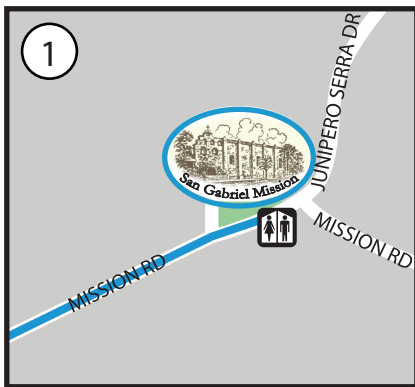

Finish: 125 Paseo de la Plaza, Los Angeles

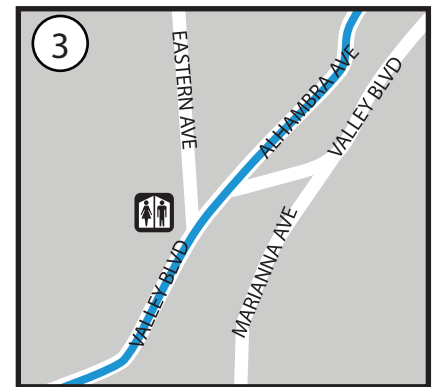
Distance: Approx. 9 Miles



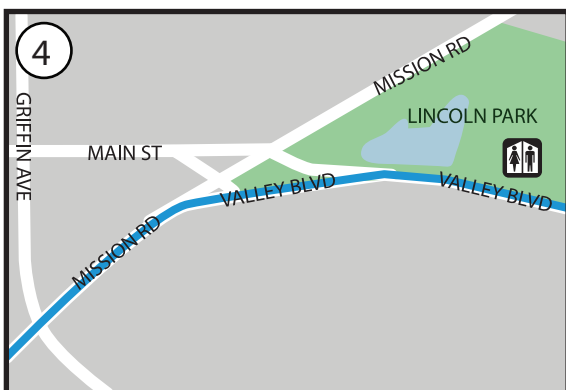
**1** From Mission San Gabriel turn right onto Junipero Serra Dr/Mission Rd.



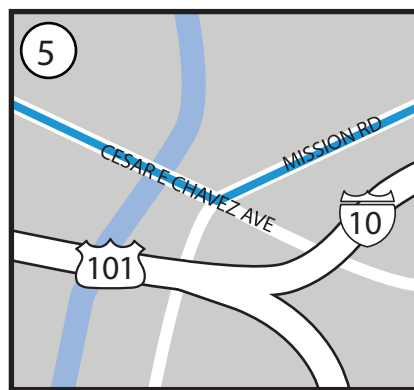
**2** Continue onto Alhambra Ave.



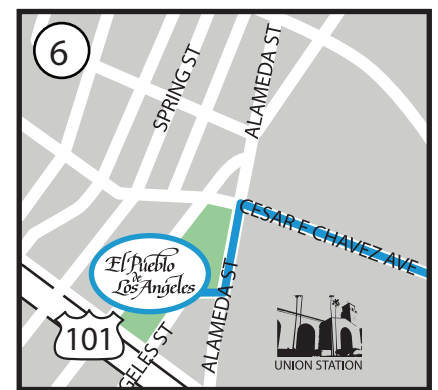
**3** Continue straight onto Valley Blvd.



**4** Slight left to stay on Valley Blvd.



**5** Turn right onto Cesar E Chavez Ave.



**6** Turn left on Alameda St.

Followed by a slight left onto Mission Rd.

Turn right onto Los Angeles St. and continue straight to arrive at El Pueblo.
