The purpose of the scoping process is to inform the public that an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) is being prepared by the Department of City Planning, gather public comment on existing conditions and environmental topics that should be analyzed, identify public and agency concerns, define the issues that will be examined in the EIR, and help to identify project impacts, alternatives, and mitigation measures that can lessen any significant environmental impacts from the proposed planning effort.

The deadline for submitting preliminary comments is August 15, 2018. All written comments submitted will be considered during preparation of the Draft EIR, which will be available for public review at a later date.
