b. September 2020—on screen but not attached to Agenda. Discussion. No public comment. Motion to vote—(Edelman/Febre). Rollcall vote—unanimous—14 aye.

13. Discussion, possible action to support Public Safety Committee's "Project Winter Holiday Donation Drive" for "Hope of the Valley's" bridge home at 7700 Van Nuys Bl (adjacent to Amtrak station).

17, Discussion, possible action by VNNC to review and adopt "Bylaws" changes mandated by DONE, Nov. 12, 2020. These rules describe "age qualifications" *Uniform Age Ordinance) and "Community Interest Stakeholder Ordinance" (that stakeholder must participate in a locally based charity organization).

CITY mandates this—but asks we discuss—and ratify it ourselves.

Voters can be 16—be 14 to vote for or be seated in Youth seat—but any Youth member must be 18 to vote on NC funding.

Motion to vote—(Browning/Febre). Vote by acclamation—unanimous.

18, Discussion, possible action to agree to DONE's request that all Planning Committee members attend the "Planning I0I seminar" series. PLUM Chair Hendry agrees—he will submit names of members.

Motion to vote—vote by acclamation—unanimous.

President Woolf announces he will step down as President, after this meeting, because of the time demands of the position.

A transition is still pending. Mr. Woolf will remain a Council member. Kind comments were offered for his service as President.
