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1. **Roll Call and Pledge of Allegiance** The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM by President Schreiner. Roll was called by John Hendry. There were eleven (11) Boardmembers present. Four (4) Boardmembers were absent. Quorum was met. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by John Camera.

2. **Reports from Government officials:**

- a. LAPD Van Nuys Division - <https://vnnc.org/resource/> SLO Perez reported that some of the officers are out on leave, but all requests will be answered. SLO Perez handed out the Van Nuys Basic Car map that includes the SLOs' contact information. The map can be found at <https://lapdonlinestrgeacc.blob.core.usgovcloudapi.net/lapdonlinemedia/2022/02/vnys-slo-map-aug-2021.pdf> There are currently five (5) SLO officers that make up the current detail. The top intersections for traffic collisions are Sherman Way and Woodman, Bolton and Victory, Ranchito and Victory, and Saticoy and Van Nuys. There were 85 collisions for the first six months of this year. Twenty of those collisions were serious and four (4) resulted in death and 61 were DUI related. So, if you are out at night, be careful about your surroundings.
- b. LAFD Deputy Chief Conroy reported about water safety and that there were 68 drownings in the County last year and that is about average year after year. This is the leading cause in death in children

from one to four in age. This topic affects all races, income levels, and genders equally. This tragedy is avoidable by proper supervision of children, fencing around pools with alarms, proper lessons, and no alcohol with water activities, These practices can reduce the number of drownings in our pools, lakes, rivers, and bathtubs.

- d. Council District 4 – Ryan Ahari ryan.ahari@lacity.org 213-473-7004 reported that August 1st was the deadline for COVID rent relief. Do not self-evict. There are resources to connect renters to resources facing eviction. More information can be found at <https://housing.lacity.org/> Motion to require that all in-person and virtual committee meetings be available for Spanish translation. It was implemented last week and now Spanish speakers will be able to connect to their government. Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council Movies in the Park August 26th Event starts at 6:00PM and the movie starts at 8:00PM. The movie will be Super Mario Brothers and there will be free treats and this will be the last movie for the year.
- e. Council District 6 – President Schreiner introduced Councilwoman Imelda Padilla. She reported that it was very important to be at the meeting and that she would stay and listen for about an hour. It will take a few more weeks until they fill the field deputy position for the Van Nuys area. Mr. Hendry informed Ms. Padilla about a historic copy of the City seal on a private property that might be able to be saved.

Mr. Harari expressed concern to the DONE rep that it would cost the VNNC roughly \$12,000 per year to pay for Spanish interpretation of monthly Board meetings (over 1/3 of total NC budget) and suggested that the City Council should pay for this expense.

Proposing new construction on vacant site of a 268,229 sq. ft., 405-unit apartment development (including 41 affordable units for Extremely Low Income) in a 6-story, 66-foot building with 2.83 to 1 FAR, 32,813 sq. ft. open space, 556 vehicular spaces, and 194 bike spaces. TOC Tier 3. Specific actions requested from City include (1) Pursuant to TOC Guidelines, seeking additional incentives for increase height (up to 22 ft.) and reduction of open space (by up to 25%); and (2) seeking Site Plan Review approval for a multi-family residential building with more than 50 units.
