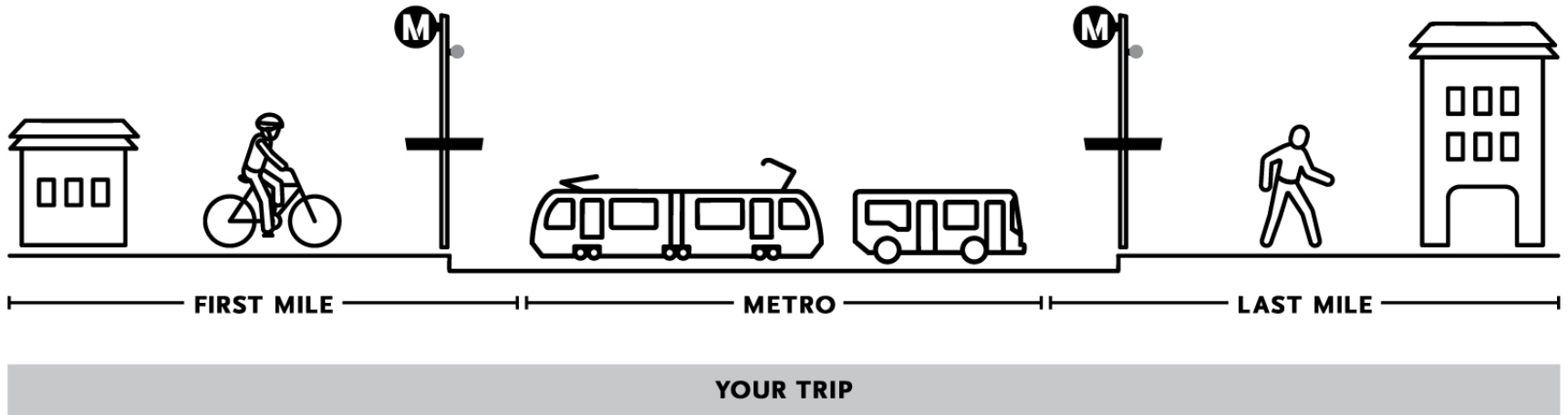

# Project Background

- > G Line Improvements Project: grade separate G Line busway above Sepulveda Blvd
- > First/Last Mile (FLM) Plan developed in 2021 to **identify walking, biking, and rolling improvements** near Sepulveda Station
- > Project will **select improvements from FLM Plan for implementation** with Metro Active Transport (MAT) Program funding (\$3.6M) awarded to StreetsLA
