Van Nuys Station Demolition: Bus and Bike Detours

Summary:

G Line Improvements Project will enhance the existing line by incorporating grade separations, advanced signal technology, bike path upgrades, and a four-quadrant gating system to facilitate faster trips. As early as February 21, 2025, Metro will close Van Nuys Station, and their contractor, Valley Transit Partners (VTP), will initiate the construction of two bridges at Van Nuys Bl and Vesper Av and a new aerial station at Van Nuys Bl.

- **Construction Date:** February 21, 2025, through late 2027.
- **Work Location:** Metro G Line alignment between Van Nuys Bl and Sepulveda Bl.
- **Construction Work Hours:** Monday to Friday from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

Intermittent Weekend work from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM or Nighttime Work from 9:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Weather permitting.

**Depending upon variance permit approvals from the City of Los Angeles*

What to Expect:

- **Full Van Nuys Station and Parking Lots Closure including the removal of TAP Vending Machines:** Metro's contractor will demolish the existing Van Nuys Station to construct bridges at Van Nuys Bl and Vesper Av and a new aerial station at Van Nuys Bl.
- **East and West Van Nuys Bl Pedestrian Sidewalk Closures:** A pedestrian walkway will be maintained along the north and south sides of Van Nuys Bl.
- **Bus and Bike Path Detours:** Detours of the G Line bus route and bike path will be implemented during construction.
 - **G Line Bus:** Rerouted along Oxnard St between Sepulveda Bl and Woodman Av, with a temporary stop on Oxnard St at Van Nuys Bl.
 - **Bike Path:** Detoured between Tyrone Av and Sepulveda Bl.

- **Sepulveda Station Parking Lot access restricted at Sepulveda BI:** Access parking lot from Haskell Av or Erwin St.

Additional Information:

- The G Line Busway will be closed to all traffic between Sepulveda BI and Woodman Av.
- Long-term temporary parking is available at G Line Sepulveda Station with access via Haskell Av or Erwin St.
- All work must receive necessary permits and approvals prior to work beginning.
- Noise and dust control measures will be in place to minimize impacts.
- Construction is a dynamic process and work schedules and timelines are subject to change.
